CULTURE TOUR THROUGH ZELL AM SEE

LOCATION INFORMATION SEE TOWN MAP

1 SCHLOSS ROSENBERG – TOWN HALL Brucker Bundesstrasse 2

A traditional Salzburg residence built on quadratic foundations with four corner towers and one central tower. Constructed in 1583 and named after the builders, Karl and Hans Rosenberger. 1970 bought by the town and became the town hall.

2 MUSEUM VOGTTURM (KASTNERTURM) town square

Medieval defence and residential tower and landmark of the town. Probably built in the 12th century to control a trade route to Italy. Can be visited as part of the Museum Vogtturm.

3 SAINT JOHANNES VON NEPOMUK town square

In order to protect themselves from further flooding, the people of Zell built a chapel in 1770 to honour the Saint of Bridges, Saint Nepomuk, in the market square. Saint Johannes Nepomuk (christened Johannes Welfin) was born in Pomuk, near Prague in 1350. He was seen as devout, incorruptible and an excellent preacher.

4 TOWN FOUNTAIN town square

In 1588 Archbishop Wolf Dietrich von Raitenau gave the fountain to tenure. In 1885 it became the property of the Zell am See market town. In 1894 a water pipe was constructed and the fountain taken away. In 1954 the fountain was erected once again with the aid of donations from the local population. Important historical events of the town are depicted on its side panels.

5 DISTRICT COUNCIL OFFICES town square

A Gothic house constructed before 1500. Bought by the Archbishop Wolf Dietrich in 1606, it became the administrative centre for rural judges. Redesigned between 1841–1848. Then in the hands of the treasury from 1867, the federal government from 1928, the German Reich from 1942, the parish of Zell am See from 1943 and finally it became the property of the State of Salzburg in 1971.



6 'ST. HIPPOLYT' PARISH CHURCH town square

Roman construction with Gothic extensions, probably dating from the 11th century. The high altar and side altar, as well as the tricoloured window, date from the neo-Gothic period (around 1900). The church contains a series of ancient, red marble tombstones originating from the year 1372.

7 MARIEN CHAPEL near parish church

The Marien Chapel was built, in 1774, on the site of 'Our Lady of the Forest' Church which was destroyed by fire in 1770. The most admired cult object of this chapel is a painting of the 'Ährenkleidmadonna', called the 'wheat woman of the Pinzgau' by the locals.

8 THE 'AUSTRIAN FOUNTAIN' at Grand Hotel

Designed by the famous Austrian artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser. The fountain can be admired near the Grand Hotel terrace beside the lake. Hundertwasser dedicated the fountain to the nine provinces of Austria, each represented by a column.

9 ESPLANADE at Grand Hotel

The Esplanade is a pedestrian walkway directly on the shore of Lake Zell and invites to leisurely walks. It leads to Elisabeth Park where a view onto Lake Zell and the shining stars on the lake can be enjoyed.






CULTURE TOUR THROUGH KAPRUN

1 JAKOBSKAPELLE

The castle chapel, dedicated to St. James (the Greater) has been standing on a slope, to the west of the castle, since 1562. The chapel has a simple ground plan typical of the 16th Century. Its contemporary appearance with a so-called ridge turret (a wooden tower jutting up from the roof), square windows and interior design, is due to Barock renovations from 1743-1736. There is an inscription referring to this alteration on the triumphal arch.



2 MEMORIAL TO A RUSSIAN BURIED UNDER THE CASTLE

A memorial to the Russian buried under the castle was subsequently placed.

3 TOWN HALL Wilhelm Fazokas Strasse 20 a

The town hall was built in 1953-1954 under Mayor Dipl.-Ing. Friedrich Nyvelt according to the plans of the architects Dipl.-Ing. Kurt Glondys and Dipl.-Ing. Erich Dorn. After a general refurbishment in 2017, the municipal office, the police inspection, the post office and an insurance office are currently housed.

4 ANTON THUSWALDNER FOUNTAIN Salzburgerplatz

The fountain at the 'Salzburgerplatz' was created in 1980 by artist Anton Thuswaldner. The round stone fountain is decorated with typical figures of the artist.

5 KAPRUN PARISH CHURCH 'ST. MARGARETHA', POWER PLANT CONSTRUCTION-MEMORIAL PLAQUE, MEMORIAL SITE Kirchbichl

The Barock church was rebuilt to its contemporary neo Gothic form in 1900. It is dedicated to St. Margarethe and was renovated, inside and out, from 2006-2009. The memorial plaque in the cemetery commemorates the many victims during the construction of the power plants. The memorial in the church cemetery was built in remembrance of the many unknown dead of Kaprun.

6 MEIXNERHAUS Kirchbichl

The Meixnerhaus dates from 1714 - this is written on the ridge of its roof. The cellar appears to be substantially older. The house has belonged to the parish rectory since 1912 and is used for many different parish occasions and events: ranging from choir practices to Christmas singing, from ministrant's lessons to Advent on Kaprun's Kirchbichl.

7 BARBARAKAPELLE Barbarastrasse

The Barbara Chapel is a modest construction, rebuilt in 1953-1954, according to plans by Fidelius Schmid. The five-sided apse, with a south-facing vestry, adjoins the hip-roofed nave on the eastern side. The ridge turret, with its high pointed spire, is situated over the western front wall. Square windows structure the building. There is a niche with the Station of the Cross, over the north-west entrance, with the mosaic inscription 'Jesus carries the Cross on his shoulders'.

8 ANTON THUSWALDNER-SCULPTURES AND PICTURES former Villa Bürg (parking Sigmund-Thun-Gorge)

One can view many sculptures and paintings by this artist in the former Villa Bürg. Numbers and letters are always integrated into Thuswaldner's sculptures and paintings, so that the artist's message can be conveyed to the viewers.

9 STEINERBAUERNHAUS Kaprun Museum

The 'Steinerbauernhaus' on the 'Kirchbichl' is a traditional log house. In the course of its over 300 years of history, the building has passed between private owners and the church until it finally went into the ownership of the Kaprun municipality in 1995. The building was rescued through renovations and has been home to the Kaprun Museum since 2009.

The museum presents the history of vehicles from the 50s to the 70s – the “economic wonder years” – as well as older cars, tractors, motorbikes, small cars, the biggest convertible in the world and an 1893 steam locomotive. The sensation: the original no. 4 wagon from the world-famous Vienna Big Wheel.
