Blue mountain trails: Easy trails, which require neither mountain experience, nor any special equipment.

Red mountain trails: Require sufficient fitness and a minimum of equipment for hiking. At least one person in the group ought to have some experience of hiking tours in the mountains.

Black mountain trails: For experienced hikers. Every participant has to be aware of the risks and needs a good head for heights. Suitable mountain experience is necessary.
